Appointed by/Responsible to:

Chairman:

Meetings will be chaired by the Vicar/Priest in Charge.

Meeting Frequency:

The Team will meet weekly or as directed by the Vicar/Priest in Charge.

Sub Groups:

The Ministry Staff Team will work with those responsible for 1) outreach, 2) making and growing disciples, and 3) worship across all ages and categories of people including:

Outreach:

- Connections/CafeConnections services
- Baptisms, Weddings & Funerals (including burials and interments)
- Mission Partners & Charities
- Social action (foodbank, Community fund....)
- Wellesbourne Youth Services
- partners – including Churches Together
- Wellesbourne School
- Little Angels
- Alpha Courses
- Men's Curry Nights

Discipleship:

- Mothers Union
- Women Alone
- Small Groups
- Pastoral care and home communions

Worship:

- Services (music, St Peter's singers, Faith in 40 & Café Connections planning teams, Taize, children, youth, Connections ...)
- Prayer chain /prayer diary
- Sheltered housing worship

The Ministry team will also support St Peter's communication & administration:

- Website and administration
- Wellesbourne and Walton News
