

## St Peter's Wellesbourne

**Role:** Working with vulnerable adults

**Role Outline:** This work involves working with adults in the individual's home, visiting, escorting to appointments, bereavement visiting, taking home communion, praying with them.

**Appointed by/Responsible to:** PCC/The Associate Minister

**Skills/Experience needed:** A love for sharing the care and compassion of Jesus

**Main tasks:**

This will vary depending on the capacity in which the individual needs to make contact with the vulnerable adult but may include:

- Visiting someone who is unwell or just come out of hospital to provide practical help and support.
- Taking/Escorting someone to hospital being sure that personal car insurance covers this activity
- Transporting a vulnerable adult to an organised event, meeting or social; occasion making sure the car insurance covers this activity
- Offering a social visit to check the individual is managing/needs additional help and taking the necessary action
- Undertaking a bereavement visit as requested by the person who has taken the funeral and offering a listening ear and support as appropriate
- Arranging to take home communion and administering the sacrament as per rota
- Offering to pray with an individual
- Offering a communal meeting event such as the Wednesday club
- Alerting the Safeguarding Officer about any concerns for a vulnerable adult identified by themselves, carers or other volunteers
- Attend training as required
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**Additional Info:** DBS check.

**Time Commitment:** This depends on the role being asked to undertake and is flexible but being sure to avoid a dependency situation.
